

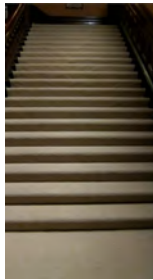

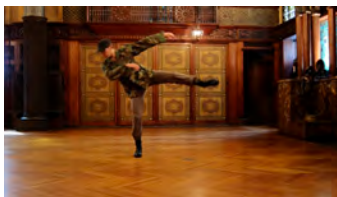
'COMPANY K-SALON SERIES', series of intimate salon events, with performances by guest artists, scheduled throughout the year; dates TBA.



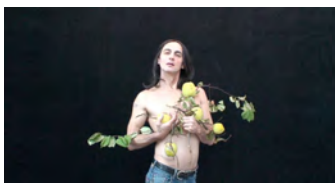
'DISCHARGE', an installation comprised of 50 black & white portraits of military personnel discharged as a result of the U.S. Military's 'Don't Ask Don't Tell' policy. October 13-23, 2010.



'MUSE ASCENDING A STAIRCASE', a series of 10 video vignettes focusing on a specific characters from Kelly's performance history. Shot on location on an interior staircase of the 7th Regiment Armory, this project pays homage to Marcel Duchamp's famous painting 'Nude Descending A Staircase', which caused a scandal at the 1913 Armory Show (at New York City's 69th Regiment Armory.)



'COHESION', a dance for dancer Justin Leaf, choreographed at the Armory, and commissioned through the Mc Knight Foundation's 'Solo' Series; will premiere at the Southern Theatre, Minneapolis, July 8th, 2010.



'THE ESCAPE ARTIST', a workshop of a solo performance work containing video renderings of the paintings of Caravaggio, as experienced by a fallen trapeze artist. Includes 9 original songs by John Kelly & Carol Lipnik. Fall, 2010.
